Names like these have a particular resonance for connoisseurs of extreme high-end watchmaking.

commissioned by Ekaterina, muse and gallerist. Obviously, this level of rarity and exactingness is reserved for a privileged international customer base. Often, these happy few become faithful fans, following the careers of their favourite watchmakers and buying several models over the years, rather the way some 19th century art lovers collected Impressionist masterpieces.
